He is a recipient of the Liebig scholarship.

His research interests include Organic chemistry; dye chemistry: preparation and investigation of highly stable fluorescent dyes; reaction mechanisms: rearrangements; solvent effects: polar properties of solvent mixtures; analytics: water determination, fluorescent marker, fluorescent immunoassays; polymer chemistry and polymeric natural products.
